

Through advanced and developmental education and research approaches of the pharmaceutical sciences, the school trains independent and genuine researchers equipped with superior creativity, deep insight, great research planning abilities, strong leadership and global competitiveness. Specifically, the school cultivates human resources who play an active role as professionals engaged in the discovery, development and planning of new drugs in the pharmaceutical industry, faculty members at universities, researchers of public institutions, administrative officers in the area of medical care, public welfare, pharmaceutical affairs and environmental sciences. All applicants must meet one of the following criteria as of March 31, 2025:

- (1) Those who with master's or professional degrees and those who are expected to obtain such a degree by March 31, 2025
- (2) Those who have been awarded a degree equivalent to a master's or professional degree in a foreign country or are expected to receive such a degree by March 31, 2025
- (3) Those who have a degree from a foreign graduate school by virtue of having completed a program at an educational institution in Japan positioned as belonging to that country's school educational system and being separately designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as such or those who are expected to do so by March 31, 2025
- (4) Those who have been awarded a degree equivalent to a master's or professional degree by completing classes remotely in Japan, offered by a school abroad, or are expected to do so by March 31, 2025
- (5) Those who have completed courses at the United Nations University, which was established under the General Assembly Resolution of the United Nations on December 11, 1972, and is prescribed in Article 1 No.2 of the Act on Special Measures Incidental to Enforcement of the "Agreement between the United Nations and Japan regarding the Headquarters of the United Nations University" and have been awarded a degree equivalent to a master's degree or those who are expected to be awarded such a degree by March 31, 2025
- (6) Those who have completed an educational course at a foreign school, an educational institution designated in (3) above, or a United Nations University and have passed an examination equivalent to that provided for in Article 16-2 of the Graduate School Establishment Standards, or are expected to pass the examination by March 31, 2025, and who have been recognized as having academic ability equivalent or superior to persons who have a master's or professional degree based on individual examination of their admission qualifications by this graduate school.
- (7) Those who designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- (8) Those who will reach 24 years of age by March 31, 2025 and have been recognized as having academic ability equivalent or superior to persons who have a master's or professional degree based on individual examination of their admission qualifications by this graduate school.

Those who are applying under the criteria of (8) and (9) must go through a preliminary screening before submitting the application. Please refer to "Preliminary Screening of Application Qualification" on Page 9.




